This Edited Volume is primarily intended to publish researches from theses by Doctoral Students and their Supervisors. Extract of outstanding Master degree researches as well as outcome of research work by scholars across the globe, who are in partnership or collaborative research with Babcock University staff and, or students will also find this outlet useful. High profile inter-disciplinary or multi-disciplinary papers and researches are much welcomed. These series are collections of peer-reviewed papers and they cover the areas of Agriculture, Microbiology, Basic Sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, and Physics); Basic Medical Science (Anatomy, Biochemistry, Nutrition-Dietetics and Physiology), Nursing Sciences and Public and Allied Health and all other areas life sciences.

Papers submitted for assessment and publication must be original, between 3500 and 8000 words in double spacing, thoroughly researched, and written in good English or French in the American Psychological Association (APA 6) Style of documentation with an abstract of not more than 250 words, and a list of not more than five keywords. Tables should be presented without gridlines and with titles on top typed in double spacing and numbered in Arabic numerals (1,2,3,...). Figures and plates should be titled at the lower side of the page and also numbered in Arabic numerals. Taxonomic or botanical names should follow the current international rules for Nomenclature. Soft copies of papers, typed in Microsoft® Word, should be submitted via e-mail attachment to: lifesciences.cpgs@babcock.edu.ng. The paper should be submitted with a signed Cover Letter (in a separate Microsoft® Word or pdf file), indicating Conflict of Interest of Authors and affirming that the same manuscript is not under review in any publication outlet and would not be so submitted, till a final decision is taken by the Editorial Team of CTLSR. Publication will be biannually. **Deadline for submission of papers towards** the June Edition is April 30, 2022, whereas October 30, 2022 is the deadline for submission towards the December Edition of this Publication.

For efficient peer-review of papers, the first page of all papers submitted for assessment

must be a Cover Page, containing the following information:
